





With the largest class to sit the IB Diploma examinations at The Aga Khan Academy, Mombasa having recently completed their exams in May, there is much reason to celebrate our graduates. 66 students sat the exam with 89% successfully attaining their Diploma. The



students scored an average of 31.4 points out of 45, as compared to 31.2 points in the previous year. While the growth is modest, it signals a success in two areas: the increase in cohort size from 37 (in 2012) to 66 (in 2013), and the graduation of our first MYP Certificate holders.

Our MYP students, comprising 44% of class, scored an average of 31.8, exceeding the school's overall average.





Our graduates received acceptances to 89 different universities around the world, including from countries such as the United States, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, Netherlands, South Africa and Kenya. Prestigious universities accepting our students this year include the University of California Berkeley (US), Dartmouth College (US), University College London (UK), King's College (UK), University of Toronto (Canada), University of British Columbia (Canada) and McGill University (Canada).

During their Diploma Programme, students take a broad range of subjects from at least five different disciplines. This rich foundation of knowledge and skills in more tradiational subjects, coupled with their CAS, Theory of Knowledge and Extended Essay experiences, allows the IB's Diploma Programme to remain as one of the most rigorous pre-university courses available. Our graduates are pursuing degree courses in fields such as Engineering, Bio-Chemistry, Kinesiology, Psychology, Economics, Politics, Literature and Business.
