Overview

It is part of the Aga Khan Academies network of schools being established in 14 countries in Africa, Asia and the Middle East. The Academies are part of the Aga Khan Development Network.

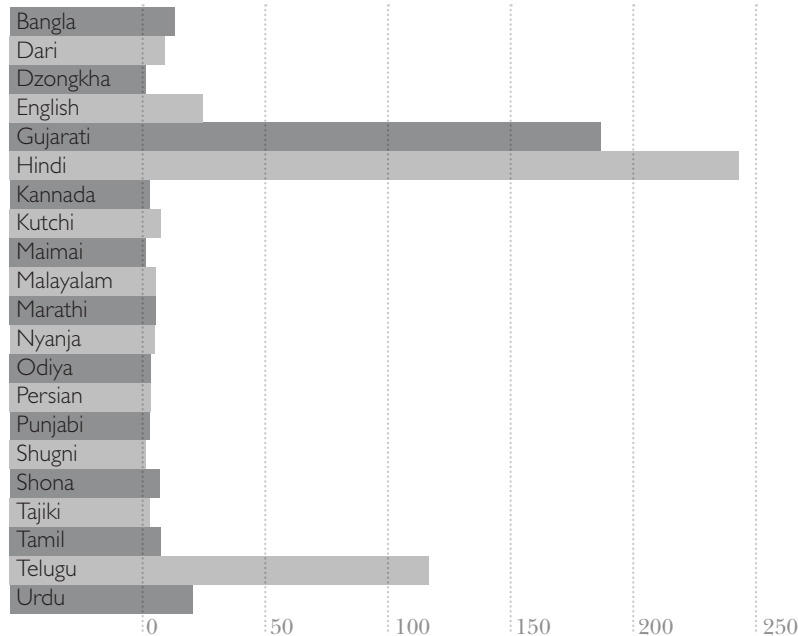

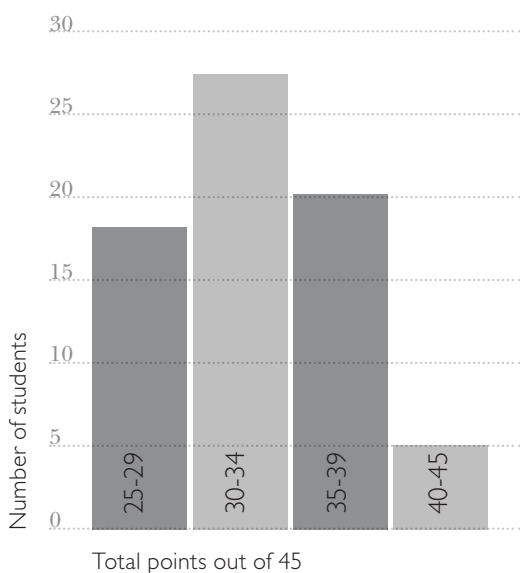


Unique service internships

Grade distribution chart: Projected grades for Class of 2017

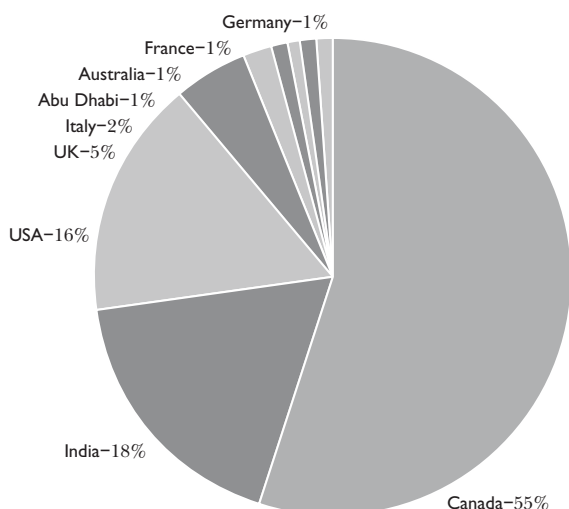
