Important information

- Please note that fee structures are subject to annual review and usually increase by at least the rate of inflation, intimated via our website 4 months prior to the start of the academic year.
- Cash payments for Academy and other fees are not permitted to be paid at the Academy's Finance Office, but must be deposited directly at any DCB branch. The deposit slip **must** include the student's name and identification number. A copy of the deposit slip must be submitted at our Finance Office within 15 days of depositing the money for issuance of payment receipt.
- A sibling discount of 5%, only on tuition fees, will be applicable to the second and subsequent children.
- If a student wishes to withdraw from the Academy, a half term's advance notice is required in writing to the Admissions Department with a copy to the Finance Department, failing which a half term's fees will be charged in lieu of the notice period. Academy clearance will not be possible until the account is settled in full.



Financial aid

- The family must demonstrate genuine need for financial assistance through particulars requested in the Financial Aid form. Applications are to be renewed annually.
- Financial aid will only be eligible for students who show good academic progress.
- Annual renewal of financial aid depends on the student's academic performance and discipline.
- Canvassing of any kind will lead to disqualification.
- The Financial Aid Committee reserves the right to deviate from these guidelines as it sees fit.
